## **Cole Offers General Assembly Scholarships**

GRAYSLAKE – State Representative Sandy Cole (R-Grayslake) is currently accepting applications for the Illinois General Assembly scholarships to be awarded for the Fall 2010 and Spring/Summer 2011 semesters. High school seniors and college students returning as sophomores and juniors are encouraged to apply for this one-year, full tuition scholarship.

“With the high price of college tuition in today’s uncertain economic climate, I am glad to be able to offer eight scholarships that will assist students in my district with their tuition expenses,” said Representative Cole.

To be eligible for the scholarships, students must reside within the 62<sup>nd</sup> District which includes all or portions of: Gages Lake, Grandwood Park, Grayslake, Gurnee, Hainesville, Ingleside, Lake Villa, Lindenhurst, Old Mill Creek, Round Lake Beach, Round Lake Heights, Round Lake Park, Third Lake, Wadsworth and Wildwood.

General Assembly scholarships can **only be used** at the following state-supported universities: Chicago State, Eastern Illinois, Governors State, Illinois State, Northern Illinois, Northeastern Illinois, Southern Illinois in Carbondale and Edwardsville, University of Illinois and Western Illinois.

Residents can also call the office at 847-543-0062 to request that an application be mailed directly to the student. The deadline to submit completed applications is Monday March 22, 2010.

Completed applications will be forwarded to an independent, bipartisan scholarship review committee for consideration.
